*Retired Home League Secretary Regulation*

The Home League Secretary shall be eligible to retire with her rank, provided she is recommended by the Corps Officer as a worthy and consistent Salvationist, and that her continuous local officership in a Senior Pastoral Care Council position amounts to not less than twenty years, with the last five in the position of Home League Secretary. She will be designated the Retired Home League Secretary.

*Pin With Gold Wreath*

The Home League pin with the gold wreath is the official retirement pin for the Home League Secretary in recognition of her service. It is issued from the Territorial Women's Ministries Department upon request by the Divisional Women's Ministries Secretary on the recommendation of the Corps Officer.

*Retirement Certificate*

Certificates are sent by the **Territorial Secretary for Women's Ministries** by means of application from the Corps Officer through DHQ.

*Retirement Ceremony*

This occasion offers excellent opportunity for honoring long and faithful service, and should be made a fitting ceremony in recognition of the retiring Home League Secretary.
